***Blackboard or 'Slate' Surface Terrestrial Globe, by George Philip & Son, London, Early 20th Century
Inventory No. 82560***

This globe was manufactured by George Philip & Son to teaching purposes. It is supported by a mahogany pedestal frame with tripod legs. The surface of the 19-inch diameter globe is black matt metal, suitable for use with chalk as a blackboard-type surface, and has an outline world map in white. The globe frame also includes brass holder.

It is inscribed, "PHILIPS' / "SLATE" SURFACE GLOBE / (19" diameter) / George Philip and Son, Ltd. / 32 Fleet Street London, E.C.4 / Made in Great Britain." printed on globe surface.
